Sixth Suspect Surrenders In Simpson Robbery Case

(CBS) LOS ANGELES Las Vegas police detectives Friday afternoon raided the Alhambra home of memorabilia dealer Tom Riccio in connection with the O.J. robbery case.

They reportedly confiscated audio recordings made during the memorabilia meeting, arranged by Riccio.

Riccio had previously leaked audio recording of O.J. Simpson's alleged memorabilia robbery to celebrity Web site TMZ.

Riccio has a criminal record, including grand larceny in Florida in 1984, when he received three years of probation; and felony arson in 1995, in California, for which he was sentenced to two years.

Riccio has reportedly struck an immunity deal with authorities in exchange for his cooperation in the case.
